- And finally, if you are ill please do not come into the Centre, you will be asked to leave.

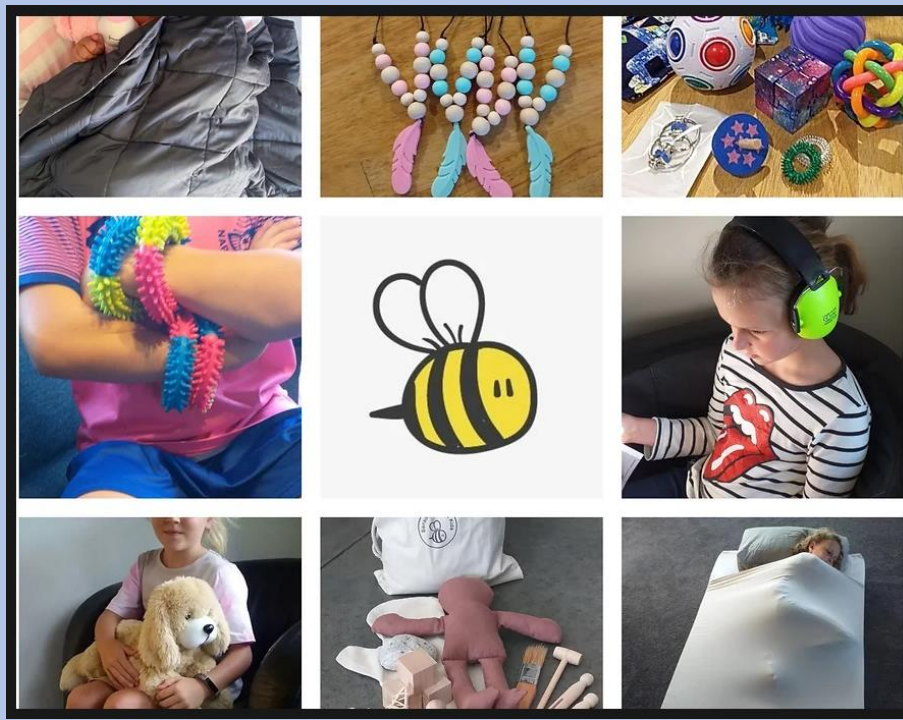
Introducing a new local business
