Encouragement and support for people with disabilities Disability Resource Centre (H.B.) Trust is a Charitable Trust working to promote opportunities and facilities for the independence, mobility, and recreation of people with disabilities as well as providing occupational, social and personal opportunities and facilities.

We also distribute information and provide assistance to our community and overall foster, encourage and support the work of people with disabilities. Within the organisation we have three main services:

Turning Point (Community Activities) is a service assisting people with disabilities to be valued contributors to their community, helping them to have the confidence, skills and support of their families and friends to reach their potential.

Network Personnel (Supported Employment) assists people with a difference to plan their careers, find employment, and provide ongoing in-work support to ensure successful outcomes

for their clients. It provides a free supported recruitment service to employers, which enables businesses to broaden their access to the labour market and thus diversify the workplace.

SCOPZE Day Service

(Day respite for people with disabilities) offers supported community activities and day services for older people with disabilities/dementia. SCOPZE Day Service has friendly, caring support workers who work with the clients and families to structure a pleasant, supportive, individualised selection of activities for people to enjoy both within the dwelling and in the local community. Staff are qualified to carry out personal cares for those requiring this service and the facility has full access for people with disabilities.
